## 35<sup>th</sup> Deutscher Orientalistentag

### 8.-12. September 2025 in Erlangen (Germany)

We cordially invite you to the 35<sup>th</sup> Deutscher Orientalistentag (DOT) at Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg. The DOT has been regularly convened by the Deutsche Morgenländische Gesellschaft (DMG) since 1921 and takes place every 3–5 years at a university of the German-speaking area.

The DOT covers all sub-disciplines of Oriental studies, both regionally and in terms of subject matter. Therefore, it is one of the world's most important conferences in the field. Participation does not require DMG membership.

In addition to single conference presentations (talks), participants are welcome to propose panels, which shall be integrated into a specific section. When proposing panels, we ask that at least three participants be named.

The 35<sup>th</sup> DOT also offers the possibility of presenting a poster. This option aims to promote young academics in our disciplines. We thus warmly encourage advanced students and doctoral candidates in the early stages of their research to participate actively in the DOT.

Abstracts for presentations, panels and posters should have a maximum text length of 250 words and contain 3–5 key references. Abstracts from the following **subject areas** can be submitted via the registration portal of the 35<sup>th</sup> DOT:
